In response to the COVID - 19 pandemic, Care One has added various class options which include Nurse Aide 1 Day, Evening, Track, & Weekend (CNA 1), Phlebotomy, Nurse Aide 2 (CNA 2), Nurse Aide 2 (CNA 2) Competency, Nurse Aide 1 Refresher, Medication Aide, Medical Assistant Program, Medical Assistant Online, EKG Technician, CPR (BLS) (American Heart Association) and Certified Pharmacy Technician Hybrid.

Care One guides students as they navigate their education journey by providing fundamental training to equip students in the medical field careers. Care One aims to improve patient care by providing professionally competent nurse aides and other healthcare personnel. The School's philosophy encourages students to always treat patients in the same manner in which they would like to be treated. The School also encourages students to create a basic response to the changing needs and conditions in the healthcare field.
